Following discussion, Councilman Timm moved to approve a resolution authorizing the City to participate in a program for aerial spraying for the purpose of mosquito eradication to mitigate the spread of West Nile Virus and providing an effective date. The motion was seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Patterson and failed by the following vote:

Following further discussion, Mayor Pro Tem Patterson moved for staff to continue ground spraying and larvacide application to combat the West Nile Virus in the City of Sachse. The motion was seconded by Councilman Timm and carried unanimously.
