**MAY 20, 2013**

The City Council of the City of Sachse held a Regular Meeting on Monday, May 20, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. at the Sachse City Hall after proper notice. The roll of the duly constituted City Council Members was called which members are as follows, to wit:

**Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance to U.S. and Texas Flags:**

The invocation was offered by Mayor Pro Tem Patterson and the pledges were led by Councilman Ronnau.

**1. Consent Agenda:**

Councilman Adams moved to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of Items 13-1541 Consider approval of the minutes of the May 6, 2013, regular Meeting; 13-1540 Consider acceptance of the resignation of Jeff Bickerstaff from the Parks and Recreation Commission; 13-1552 Resolution No. 3475 of the City Council of the City of Sachse, Texas, approving the Interlocal Agreement between the City and Dallas County for the City to retain and authorize Dallas County to maintain certain designated roadways located within the city limits; and providing for an effective date; 13-1551 Resolution No. 3476 of the City Council of the City of Sachse, Texas, awarding the bid for the Pleasant Valley Water System Improvements from Merritt Road to Eastview Drive as a capital improvement project to P.C. Contractors, LLC, in the amount not to exceed one hundred ninety thousand dollars and no cents (\$190,000.00); authorizing the City Manager to execute such agreement in a form approved by the City Attorney; and providing an effective date and 13-1511 Resolution No. 3477 of the City Council of the City of Sachse, Texas, authorizing the continued participation with the Steering Committee of Cities Served by Oncor; and

authorizing the payment of ten cents per capita to the Steering Committee of Cities Served by Oncor to fund regulatory and related activities related to Oncor Electric Delivery. The motion was seconded by Councilwoman McMillan and passed unanimously.

Following discussion, Councilman Franks moved to approve Ordinance No. 3479 adopting the amendments to the Home Rule Charter approved by the voters of the City at an election on May 11, 2013. The motion was seconded by Councilman Adams and carried unanimously.

**13-1506 Consider appointments to Boards and Commissions:**
