Attached are the unofficial results from Dallas County Elections as reported on Saturday night.

Final results and detail sheets will come from Dallas County Elections over the weekend and will be distributed as soon as received. We have 1 provisional ballot that could change the numbers but, until the Ballot Board meets and makes that determination, the numbers are not final. The majority of the time provisional ballots will not count because of voter registration issues. Overall, the numbers will remain the same as reported on Saturday night until this 1 ballot is decided.

The election process went smoothly. There was a slight delay in the returns due to a printer malfunction. Our election officials did a great job.
