The City Council of the City of Sachse held a regular meeting on Monday, November 2, 2015 at 7:30 p.m. at Sachse City Hall, 3815-B Sachse Road, Sachse, Texas. Those present were Mayor Mike Felix, Mayor Pro Tem Brett Franks, Council Members Charlie Ross, Paul Watkins, Bill Adams, Cullen King, and Jeff Bickerstaff; City Manager, Gina Nash; City Secretary, Michelle Lewis Sirianni; City Engineer, Greg Peters; Community Development Director, Dustin McAfee; Parks and Recreation Director, Lance Whitworth; Human Resources Director, Stacy Buckley; Fire Captain, Chris Hall; Police Chief, Bryan Sylvester; Finance Director, Teresa Savage; and City Attorney, Joe Gorfida.

Councilman King stated the Historical Society will host their Veteran's Day Event on Saturday, November 7 at 11:00 a.m.

Councilman Bickerstaff stated that the month of November is National Novel month and on Tuesday, November 3 the Library will be hosting Taylor Stevens at 6:00 p.m., and the library has e-books available for checkout.

Mayor Felix stated that Thursday, November 26 the Sachse High School is hosting the annual Turkey Trot; City offices will be closed on Thursday, November 26 and Friday, November 27 for the Thanksgiving Holiday; Thursday, December 3 at 6:30 p.m. will be the annual Tree Lighting at City Hall; Saturday, December 5 the Firefighter's Association will have Pancakes with Santa, and Saturday, December 12 the annual Christmas Parade and Cookies with Santa.

Mayor Felix presented June Danker with a plaque recognizing her retirement with fourteen (14) years of service to the City.

15-3089 Proclamation declaring November, 2015 as American Diabetes Month.

Mayor Felix read a proclamation declaring November, 2015 as American Diabetes month.

15-3102 Presentation on the Sachse Police Department's Medication Disposal Program.

Chief Sylvester stated that the Police Department has purchased a medication depository available to the citizens 365 days a year. It provides a safe place for medication disposal and to help eliminate medication abuse, accidental overdose by children, contaminated ground water, and accidental ingestion by animals. Chief Sylvester stated that acceptable items include: prescription medications, over the counter medications, vitamins, pet medications, and medication samples. Items that are not accepted are: needles, aerosol inhalers, thermometers, lotions or liquids, and illegal drugs. Chief Sylvester described the depository similar to a mailbox and is located inside the lobby of the Public Safety building.

CITIZENS INPUT:

Diana Smith, 4802 Sachse Road, stated that she is not against the dog park issue, but believes that trails are currently more important for the City. Trails have been listed number one the survey the past two years. Ms. Smith commented that designating the space for a dog park is the biggest problem.

REGULAR AGENDA ITEMS:

15-3112 Conduct a public hearing to consider and act on a City-initiated request to rezone approximately 10.6 acres of land, by revising Ordinance 3567 from PD 26 to PD 32 to allow for the installation of a digital radio tower for the new Public Safety P-25 radio system, generally located at 6436 Sachse Road.

Mr. McAfee introduced this item stating that the proposed rezoning request will allow for the new public safety digital radio tower. Mr. McAfee briefed the Council on the location of the subject property and the current and surrounding zoning. The Future Land Use Plan (FLUP) supports the proposed use of the public facility tower. Mr. McAfee indicated that the City did send out public notifications and of the 177 notices sent out, Community Development received no written responses and two inquiry phone calls. At the October 26, 2015 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting, one resident spoke in opposition to the proposed request citing visual and health concerns. The Planning and Zoning Commission unanimously recommended approval. Mr. McAfee stated that the proposed use is compatible with the current land uses; therefore, recommends approval.

Mayor Felix opened the public hearing.

No comments were made.

Mayor Pro Tem Franks made a motion to close the public hearing. Councilman Adams seconded that motion and the motion was unanimously approved.

Mayor Felix asked that even though the tower will be located on City property, can a request at a later date be made to lease space on the tower. Mr. McAfee responded that any changes would have to come back through City Council for approval. Councilman Bickerstaff asked if staff knew the timeline of the final design. Mr. Peters responded that final design is expected sometime around the end of the year to early January, 2016.

Mayor Pro Tem Franks made a motion to approve a request to rezone approximately 10.6 acres of land by revising Ordinance 3567 from PD 26 to PD 32 to allow for the installation of a digital radio tower for the new Public Safety P-25 radio system. Councilman King seconded that motion and the motion was unanimously approved.

15-3107 Consider a resolution of the City Council of the City of Sachse, Texas approving the terms and conditions of the Agreement for Professional Services between the City of Sachse, Texas and Cobb Fendley & Associates, Inc.; authorizing its execution by the City Manager; and providing for an effective date.

Mr. Peters introduced this item stating that the proposed agreement will allow the City to begin land surveying and design for a future elevated water tank. The CIP plan identifies the need for the storage tank especially as the City continues to grow. The elevated tank will be required to meet TCEQ requirements for 100 gallons of elevated storage per water system connection. Mr. Peters stated staff recommends approval of this request.

Councilman Watkins made a motion to approve the terms and conditions of the Professional Services Agreement with Cobb Fendley & Associates for the surveying and engineering services related to an elevated water tank. Mayor Pro Tem Franks seconded that motion and the motion was unanimously approved.

15-3106 Hear, discuss, and consider an appeal by Sachse 95 LP, a Texas Limited Partnership, regarding the construction of public infrastructure for the proposed development located at the northeast corner of Ben Road and Pleasant Valley Road.

Consider acceptance of the Quarterly Investment Report for the quarter ended September 30, 2015.

Background

The Finance Department releases a report quarterly on the City's finances. The attached report represents investments only; budget final numbers will be presented with the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report following completion of the annual audit.

The Investment Report provides investment activity details for the Money Market, Investment Pool, and Certificate of Deposit accounts. It is the strategy of the City to maintain a high percentage of idle funds invested in safe, secure and liquid investment securities and pooled investment types in accordance with the Public Funds Investment Act (PFIA) and City policy.

Cash on hand at 09/30/15 was \$27,213,051 in all funds; of this amount \$22,213,051 was available for investing. The remaining \$5,000,000 was held in a non-interest bearing analysis account per contract with American National Bank. The average interest/yield on all investments was .30%, and investment earnings totaled \$17,738.

The PFIA requires that the Investment Officers prepare and submit quarterly a written report of investment transactions for all funds covered by the Investment Policy.

Attached is the Quarterly Investment Report for the quarter ending September 30 of the fiscal year 2014-2015. This report complies with the requirements of the City's Investment Policy and the Public Funds Investment Act as amended. For this period, 2015, the City's portfolio¹ consisted of the following investments:

The City does not carry any security instrument (investment type) on its books that is traded on the open market; therefore all investments are listed at 100% of market value. Interest earnings on all certificate of deposit accounts are accreted quarterly or at maturity. All Funds on deposit with American National Bank, Independent Bank, Comerica Bank, and Investment Pools are fully secured and safeguarded. **Total investment interest earned for the quarter ending September 30 was \$17,738.**

Citywide cash and investments for the period ending September 30 was \$27,213,051. Of this amount, \$4,415,009 is for the Sachse EDC; also included is \$5,000,000.00 which is held in a non-interest bearing analysis account. It is the strategy of the Finance Department to maintain a high percentage of its idle funds invested in safe and secure investment securities and pooled investment types in accordance with the Public Funds Investment Act.

78% of the City's current portfolio has liquidity of 30 days or less, which is more than adequate for daily operations. The City investments are liquid and have same day access. The City's investment and cash management strategy will be to maintain operational and capital needs in money market accounts and liquid asset pools. The City's funds are swept into the above accounts and withdrawn as needed for operational cash flow requirements.

The average interest rate/yield on the City's investments for the period was .30%. The Texpool Prime Fund interest rate was .1591% and the Texpool interest rate was .085% at September 30, 2015. The 90 day T-bill rate was .00% with the 180 day T-bill at .08%.

The market values included in these reports were obtained by Valley View Consulting, L.L.C. from sources believed to be accurate and represent proprietary valuation. Due to market fluctuations these levels are not necessarily reflective of current liquidation values. Yield calculations are not determined using standard performance formulas, are not representative of total return yields and do not account for investment advisor fees.

Annual Comparison of Portfolio Performance

The Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) maintained the Fed Funds target range between 0.00% and 0.25% (actual Fed Funds traded +/- 10 bps). Although the domestic employment and economic conditions reflect moderate growth, longer term uncertainty and international conditions influenced the FOMC to delay "lift-off." The US stock markets retrenched from their peaks, but seem to have stabilized. International military conflicts require ongoing concern. Financial institution deposits and laddering targeted cash flows still provide the best interest earnings opportunity.

Economic Overview

9/30/2015

The Federal Open Market Committee (FOMC) maintained the Fed Funds target range between 0.00% and 0.25% (actual Fed Funds traded +/-10 bps). The FOMC met 9/16 & 17 and chose to delay "lift-off" citing global economic concerns for the first time. The September new payroll numbers were a disappointing +142k and included downward Aug and July revisions. The overall unemployment rate remained 5.1%. US stock markets experienced volatility, but did stem the decline and advanced slightly. Chinese stock market and economic concerns continue. Continuing to ladder provides strategic advantage. Municipal bonds and financial institution deposits generally provide the best interest earnings opportunity, if available. Short to medium term US Government security yields fell on the non-FOMC action and, then again, on the September payroll weakness.







Background

The applicant for the Preliminary Plat is Woodbridge Properties, LLC. The 13.86-acre (approximately 603,715 square feet) subject property is located at the northeast corner of State Highway 78 and Woodbridge Parkway (See Attachment 1 - Location Map) and retains a zoning designation of Planned Development-11 (See Attachment 2 for Zoning Map). The Preliminary Plat is shown in Attachment 3 and the Concept Engineering Plans are shown in Attachment 4.

The property is proposed to be platted into two lots, including:

- Lot 1 - 1.116 acres (to be developed)
- Lot 2 - 12.652 acres (to remain undeveloped at this time)

- Tract A, a 0.091 Acre tract (3,970 Square Feet), is included in the plat but will be dedicated to the Woodbridge Homeowner's Association.

The site will have access via driveways onto both Woodbridge Parkway and State Highway 78. The Developer is proposing a firelane connecting the two driveways, as required by the Sachse Fire Marshall. The Developer intends to construct on-site storm drainage, public

water, and public sanitary sewer improvements, in accordance with City of Sachse standards. Stormwater detention of this property was previously accounted for through the overall Woodbridge Development and the Woodbridge golf course, located downstream of the property.

A site plan for Lot 1 is attached as Attachment 5. Lot 2 will remain undeveloped at this time.

Policy Considerations

The applicant is proposing to plat the subject property into two separate lots.

No right-of-way dedications are being proposed on Woodbridge Parkway, as the road was constructed to its ultimate width in accordance with the Capital Improvements Plan and the Major Thoroughfare Plan. Pursuant to the Subdivision Ordinance, the developers of each lot will be required to pay impact fees for the development at the time of Building Permit issuance.

Staff has determined that the proposed Preliminary Plat meets the standards of the City of Sachse Code of Ordinances and is designed in accordance with the zoning of the property. 

Background

The City Council adopted an ordinance amending the no parking section of the Sachse Code of Ordinances in March 2011. This amendment clearly listed the various no parking zones in the city. Staff has prepared a proposed ordinance that further amends this section to add the following no parking zones:

Miles Road

- Location: In front of Sachse High School
- Ordinance Amendment: No stopping, standing, leaving, or parking of motor vehicles
- Safety Reason: Vehicles stopping in Miles Road during peak traffic times to drop off and pick up students (morning & afternoon) cause an increased potential for vehicle/pedestrian and vehicle/vehicle conflicts
- Limits: KOA Wood Road to Hudson Drive
- Staff Coordination:
 - Staff has met with the Principal of Sachse High School to discuss
 - Staff has received support for the ordinance from Garland ISD

Cody Lane

- Location: In front of the Mansions Development
- Ordinance Amendment: No Parking
- Safety Reason: Limited sight distance due to road geometry and parked vehicles near drive entrances
- Limits

- The southeast side of Cody Lane from a point 450 feet northeast of Ranch Road to a point 1125 feet northeast of Ranch Road.
- Per TxDOT Sight Stopping Distance
- Staff Coordination
 - Sachse PD has discussed the concern with property management staff at the Mansions
 - Staff at the Mansions has recommended to their patrons to park inside the property
 - Sachse PD has determined that a no parking zone is necessary to deter parking in areas where sight distance is limited

It is estimated that the required signs/poles will cost \$100.00 each, with a total of 24 signs needed for Miles Road and 4 signs needed for Cody Lane. The signs will be installed by Public Works and funding would be provided through the annual Public Works Street Maintenance budget.

Approve an ordinance amending the Code of Ordinances by amending Chapter 9, "Traffic Regulations" by amending Section 9-6, "Parking", to provide for no parking areas.

Chapter 9, Section 9-6(b) No Parking Areas

The parking of any vehicle within any space within the designated area which is or shall be marked "No Parking" shall be prohibited on each and every day of the year between the hours of 12:01 a.m. and 12:00 midnight.
- (1) *Violation.* It shall be unlawful and a violation of the provisions of this division for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle operated by such person to be parked within the area herein designated as "No Parking."
- (2) *Areas designated.*

Location #1 - Miles Road

- Location: In front of Sachse High School
- Ordinance Amendment: No stopping, standing, leaving, or parking of motor vehicles
- Safety Reason: Vehicles stopping in Miles Road during peak traffic times to drop off and pick up students (morning & afternoon) cause an increased potential for vehicle/pedestrian and vehicle/vehicle conflicts
- Limits: KOA Wood Road to Hudson Drive
- Staff Coordination:
 - Staff has met with the Principal of Sachse High School to discuss
 - Staff has received support for the ordinance from Garland ISD



Location #2 - Cody Lane

- Location: In front of the Mansions Development
- Ordinance Amendment: No Parking
- Safety Reason: Limited sight distance due to road geometry and parked vehicles near drive entrances
- Limits
 - The southeast side of Cody Lane from a point 450 feet northeast of Ranch Road to a point 1125 feet northeast of Ranch Road.
 - Per TxDOT Sight Stopping Distance
- Staff Coordination
 - Sachse PD has discussed the concern with property management staff at the Mansions
 - Staff at the Mansions has recommended to their patrons to park inside the property
 - Sachse PD has determined that a no parking area is necessary to deter the parking of vehicles where sight distance is limited

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SACHSE, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY AMENDING CHAPTER 9, "TRAFFIC REGULATIONS" BY AMENDING SECTION 9-6, "PARKING", TO PROVIDE FOR NO PARKING AREAS; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Sachse has determined that an amendment to the no parking zones regulations for the city is necessary in order to clarify where no parking is permitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACHSE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances, City of Sachse, Texas, be amended, by amending Chapter 9, Traffic Regulations, Section 9-6, Parking, in part, to read as follows:

"Chapter 9

TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

...

"Sec. 9-6 Parking.

...

B. *No parking areas.* Certain areas or portions of the public streets described in this section have been, are hereby and shall hereafter be set apart, marked and designated as no parking for all vehicles owned by or operated by any person within said areas or portions of said public streets. The parking of any vehicle within any space within the designated area which is or shall be marked "No Parking" shall be prohibited on each and every day of the year between the hours of 12:01 a.m. and 12:00 midnight.

...

(1) *Violation.* It shall be unlawful and a violation of the provisions of this division for any person to cause, allow, permit or suffer any vehicle operated by such person to be parked within the area herein designated as "No Parking."

(2) *Areas Designated.* The area of the public streets of the city within which certain areas or spaces shall be marked or designated as “No Parking” shall and does hereby include:

...

j. Cody Lane

- i. The southeast side of Cody Lane from a point 450 feet northeast of Ranch Road to a point 1125 feet northeast of Ranch Road.

...

(5) It shall be unlawful and an offense for any person to stop, stand, leave, or park any motor vehicle along any curb of Miles Road from KOA Wood Road to Hudson Drive.

...”

SECTION 2. That any provisions of the ordinances of the City of Sachse in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed and any provisions not so in conflict shall remain in force and effect.

SECTION 3. Than an offense committed before the effective date of this ordinance is governed by the prior law and the provisions of the Code of Ordinances as amended, in effect when the offense was committed and the former law is continued in effect for this purpose.

SECTION 4. That should any sentence, article, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional for any reason, such judgment or holding shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Sachse, as heretofore amended, and upon conviction shall be punished by fine not to exceed the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each and every day such violation shall continue shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and publication of the caption, as the law and charter in such cases provide.
