Annual Firework display at Sachse's Red, White, and Blue Blast.

### Background

Zambelli Fireworks Company produced the City of Sachse's first firework show on July 3, 2008, in the amount of \$12,500. Since that time, Zambelli has provided Sachse's firework display each year, with this past show on July 2, 2016. The cost of the firework display with Zambelli has gone up each year. Last year Council approved a larger show for \$20,000. Since 2008, there have been new developments in how large firework shows are displayed and advances in technology. Staff thought that it was a good time to open up Sachse's premier event for bid to see what other companies may be able to offer.

After speaking with and receiving bids from three firework display companies in the area, staff has chosen and signed a contract with Pyro Shows to produce the 2017 show. Michael Walden, Vice President, of Pyro Shows is here today to present his proposal for the 2017 show and answer any questions you may have.

# BACKGROUND

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- Zambelli Fireworks Company was the original vendor in 2008.
  - Zambelli has provided Sachse's firework display each year since then with this past show on July 2, 2016.
- Fireworks Display Pricing
  - Each year, since 2008, the cost of the firework display with Zambelli has gone up. Council approving to increase the amount of shells and have Zambelli produce a larger show for \$20,000 on July 2, 2016.
- Bids for the 2017 show
  - Since 2008 there have been new developments in how large firework shows are displayed and advances in technology.
  - Staff felt that it was a good time to open up Sachse's premier event for bid to see what other companies may be able to offer.

# BID PROCESS

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- Staff met with 2 firework display companies on site and spoke to 1 company over the phone.
- Things that staff was looking for included:
  - Keep with the \$20,000 budget from this past show
  - Digital production
  - A timed show choreographed to music
  - New and creative ideas that bring something to this show that we haven't had in the past.
- 3 bids were received from the following companies:
  - Illumination Fireworks
  - Pyro Shows
  - Pyrotex

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- Staff made the decision and signed a contract to have Pyro Shows produce the firework display at the July 3, 2017 Red, White and Blue Blast.

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### Title

Discuss the future of the City of Sachse's Caboose located at the intersection of Highway 78 and 5th Street.

### Background

The City of Sachse Caboose sits at the intersection of Highway 78 and 5th is a historical landmark. City Council discussed at the September 19th Workshop some improvements that they would like to see with the Caboose. Staff is here tonight to discuss the details of those improvements, including the cost and design. Staff now has identified actual costs for the painting, lighting, landscaping, irrigation and fencing. A short presentation will identify each improvement and the cost associated with it.

Staff also met with the Sachse Historical Society on October 4 to discuss forming a partnership. The partnership will include the Sachse Historical Society restoring the inside of the caboose to its original state, scheduling tours for the public, and installing historical signate about the caboose.

# BUDGET FOR PROJECT

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- Re-paint Caboose - \$9,200
- Paint Logo – \$1,500
- Replace landscaping \$2,550
- Irrigation \$1,800
- Lighting \$6,000
- Add Signage (SHS) \$800
- Split Rail Fencing \$1,200

***Total Estimated Budget - \$23,050***

*(Sachse Historical Society will fund the signage up to \$500)*



## THE SACHSE CABOOSE

This caboose, Union Pacific RR 25613, Class CA9, was built by the International Car Company, Kenton, Ohio in April 1967. This caboose provided a place for the conductors, switchmen and brakemen to stay while the train was in transit. During the mid 1960's all cabooses were discontinued by the railroads because of new electronic switching equipment, high maintenance and safety issues. This caboose was retired by Union Pacific RR on December 26, 1990 and purchased by the City of Sachse and moved to this site on June 19, 1996. It was used as the first office of the Sachse Chamber of Commerce and currently serves as an extension of the Sachse Historical Society's Museum. Since the move to Sachse it has become a Landmark and reminder of the role the Gulf Colorado & Santa Fe Railroad played in the establishment and building of the City of Sachse.





# OCTOBER 4, 2016 MEETING WITH THE SACHSE HISTORICAL SOCIETY

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- Location: City Municipal Complex
- Date: November 2017
- 3-4 day event
- Sachse Historical Society submitted applications to two different organizations
- Notification will be received by the end of January 2017
- If they do not receive approval for the wall the Sachse Historical Society will continue applying
- Once the Historical Society receives notification that they will get the wall, a planning committee will be formed.

# REQUIREMENTS FOR THE WALL

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- Set up: must have at least 10 volunteers and 1 full day to set up the wall
- Requirements: Must be ADA accessible, lighted at night, need sufficient parking
- Volunteers
  - Assist in supervising the wall
  - Handing out information
  - Help with landscaping, flags, lighting, accessibility
  - Planning
- Other organizations

  - Cub Scouts, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts
  - City Departments
  - Fraternal Order of Police (FOP)
  - International Association of Firefighters (IAFF)
  - Exchange Club
  - Garden Club
