Canvass Results of November 7, 2017 Special Election

Background

The City jointly contracted with Dallas County and Collin County to conduct this special election. The results of the election are not final until a canvass of the results is done by the City Council. Results of the November 2017 Special Election are as follows:

Proposition A: Authorizing the creation of the City of Sachse Municipal Development District and the imposition of a sales and use tax at the rate of one-fourth (1/4) of one percent for the purpose of financing development projects beneficial to the district.

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACHSE, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7, 2017 FOR AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF THE CITY OF SACHSE MUNICIPAL DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT AND THE IMPOSITION OF A SALES AND USE TAX AT THE RATE OF ONE-FOURTH (1/4) OF ONE PERCENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS BENEFICIAL TO THE DISTRICT AND THE LEGAL SALE OF ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR OFF-PREMISE CONSUMPTION ONLY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined that the notice of the election was duly given in the form, manner and time required by law, and said election was in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with applicable laws of the State of Texas and the proceedings calling and governing the holding of such election, and;

WHEREAS, it is imperative to consider the returns of the election held on November 7, 2017, to consider the creation of the Municipal Development District and imposition of the sales and use tax, and for the legal sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption; and,

WHEREAS, the returns of said election have been duly and legally made and submitted to the City Council for canvassing, and a tabulation of the returns for the polling place and for early voting, as canvassed and tabulated by this governing body as follows:

Proposition A: Authorizing the creation of the City of Sachse Municipal Development District and the imposition of a sales and use tax at the rate of one-fourth (1/4) of one percent for the purpose of financing development projects beneficial to the district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACHSE, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Said election was duly called, that notice of said notice was given in accordance with law, and that said election was held in accordance with law, and

SECTION 2. It is determined that Proposition A approving the authorization of the creation of the City of Sachse Municipal Development District and the imposition of a sales and use tax at the rate of one-fourth (1/4) of one percent for the purpose of financing development projects beneficial to the district shall take as provided for in Section 377.106 of the Texas Local Government Code.

SECTION 3. It is determined that Proposition B approving the legal sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption only.

SECTION 4. It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of this governing body, the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place, and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located at City Hall, a place convenient and readily accessible to the general public, and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the scheduled time of said meeting.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
