- b.* Consider approval of an ordinance amending Chapter 5 “Fire Protection” by amending Section 5-1(D) and Section 5-1(E) of the Code of Ordinances by adopting provisions related to the inspection of duplex and multi-family dwellings and provisions requiring smoke detectors; Providing a repealing clause; Providing a savings clause; Providing a severability clause; Providing a penalty of fine not to exceed the sum of \$2,000 for each offense; and Providing an effective date.....Mayor
