Conduct Public Hearing and Consider an ordinance amending Chapter 11, (Zoning Ordinance) Article 3 by adding Section 12 Establishing MX-Mixed Use District; Amending the schedule of permitted uses; Providing for a repealing clause; Providing for a severability clause; Providing for a penalty of fine not to exceed \$2000 for each offense; And providing an effective date.....Mayor

Consider an ordinance amending Chapter 9 “Traffic Regulations” of the Code of Ordinances by adding Section 9-10 to be entitled “Use of Hand-Held Mobile Telephones in School Zones”; Directing the City Manager to erect signs in affected areas; Providing for a repealing clause; Providing for a severability clause; Providing for a penalty of fine not to exceed \$200 for each offense; And providing an effective date.....Mayor
